## Frequently Asked Questions

### **When does the Storytelling Summit Start?**

Registration begins at 12:30 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 13, with the conference starting at 1 p.m. The afternoon session ends at 5 p.m., with the social hour immediately following. The banquet dinner with special guest Dr. Calvin J. Watts begins at 6 p.m.

Friday's schedule kicks off at 8:30 a.m., with lunch at 11:30 a.m. The Storytelling Summit comes to a close at 3:15 p.m. Be sure to check out the full agenda.

### **Where is the Storytelling Summit taking place?**

The Storytelling Summit will be held in Gaiser Hall located on the Clark College campus at 1933 Fort Vancouver Way, Vancouver, WA 98663.
